

General Safety

Safety Requirements for Visitors

- Obtain information regarding precautions that are required for entry into hazardous areas from your Premier host or guide.
- Obtain personal protective equipment (PPE) requirements from your Premier host or guide.
- Promptly report any injuries or unsafe conditions to your Premier host or guide.
- Adhere to all Premier facility Health, Safety and Environmental rules and guidelines.
- Direct all questions or concerns related to specific facility hazards to the Premier Health Safety and Environmental Department.

PEOPLE

Our people are what is most important. If we take care of our people, they will take care of the rest.

TEAMWORK
